What will I learn?

In this introductory Key Word Sign workshop, you will learn the principles of KWS and gesture, who it can be used with and how it can be used alongside other ways of communicating. In the practical component of the course, you will learn up to 80 new signs along with common natural gestures. You will also be able to practice signs in a safe and fun group environment.
