Key Word Sign (KWS) is a strategy that can be used to support individuals with communication difficulties to understand and get their message across to others.

What will I learn?

In this introductory key word sign workshop, you will learn the principles of KWS and gesture, who it can be used with and how it can be used alongside other ways of communicating. In the practical component of the course, you will also learn up to 80 new signs along with common natural gestures, with opportunities to practice in a safe & fun group environment.
